Awards:

First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded. Green Qualifying ribbons will be given to runs with qualifying scores. Other awards may be offered.

No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of ASC of ID. Draw will be posted prior to start of trial.

- Bitches in season will run in draw order.
  - Move-ups are allowed, but they may not be recorded correctly unless written notification is provided to the trial secretary prior to the start of the trial.
  - Entry fees will be refunded only when a dog has been certified by a licensed Veterinarian as unable to compete due to sickness or injury. Owner will be responsible for all vet fees.
  - Selling runs will not be permitted unless the trial is full
  - If the trial is full and you wish to sell a run, the transaction must be handled by the trial secretary. All offers to buy or sell runs must occur before the trial starts.
  - Note that the letter designation on a trial does not indicate or restrict the order in which the trials will be held.
  - Run limits and judging assignments are subject to change.
- \*Owner of dog will be responsible for any veterinary expense to the stock. Replacement cost will be \$25.00 ducks, \$200 sheep, market value for cattle
